

## TROUBLE SHOOTING

Minute hand tracking too fast



Check position of base gear. The base gear should be flush with base and not touching minute wheel.

Hour hand not moving



Check position of hour stop and hour advance. The hour stop and hour advance should be engaged with teeth on hour ratchet.
